## Scope

This course is designed to provide workers and supervisors with knowledge and skills required when working in a confined space environment. The program covers hazards, equipment and procedures for working safely in a confined space environment and trainees will receive training and certification appropriate for Entrants and Safety Attendants for confined spaces.

## Objectives

During the course trainees will acquire knowledge and skills required to work in a confined space through a combination of lecture presentations, group discussions, and individual and team practical exercises. All trainees are required to successfully complete written and practical testing demonstrating their understanding of the course material and competency in the exercises in order to receive course certification.

### Practical

*Portable Gas Detection Systems, Tripod Access & Retrieval Systems, Davit Access & Retrieval Systems, Respiratory Protection Equipment, Communications Equipment, Lifelines & Other P.P.E., Lockout Equipment, Self Rescue Systems, Positive Pressure Ventilation Equipment, Full Body Group E Harness, Rope-based Retrieval Systems, S.C.B.A. and S.A.R. Breathing Air Systems*
